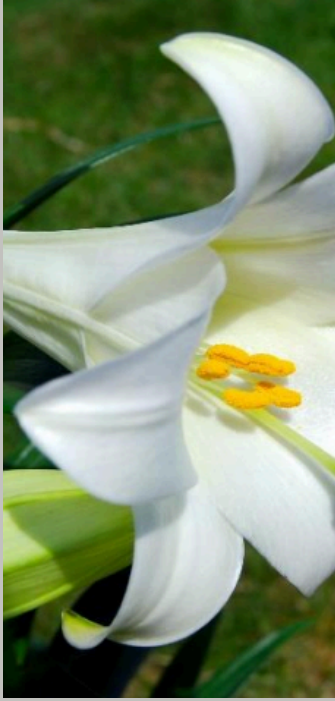

VOLUNTEERS—REMINDER!!!

The Idaho Conference has voted a NAD policy that all local volunteers be required to have background checks. We are already doing this with volunteers who work with children. This wider inclusion for all volunteers is an added measure for the safety of our children and, although requiring more involvement to maintain, is time and energy well spent. If you are renewing your screening (every three years), you may receive email reminders from ncsrisk directly (if you are over a year late, you may not receive these notices). If you have completed this process for another Adventist group (volunteering at BVAS or GSAA or another SDA Church in the NAD) you do not need to complete the process again. Either add Cloverdale to your organizations, or let the church office know and we can ask the conference office to search for your name (the system does not automatically find you).

The Cloverdale church will cover all costs associated with the screenings.

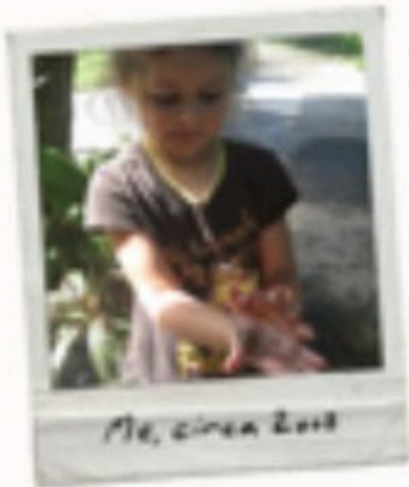

PUC Summer Experience

PacificQuest programs for grades 6-12. Each week-long program is held on the Pacific Union College campus and focuses on an area of study.

Academic programming is enriched with daily worship, recreational opportunities, team-building exercises, and evening activities. Students who successfully complete the week of programming earn 1 unit of college credit.



PQSeek - June 29-July 4, 2025, grades 6-8

STEM I Program: Students will participate in daily academic programming focused on thermochemistry, human performance, and planet health classes taught by PUC professors.



PQRise - July 6-11, 2025, grades 9-11

STEM II Program: Students will participate in daily academic programming focused on thermochemistry, human performance, and planet health classes taught by PUC professors.



PQSoar - July 6-11, 2025, grades 9-12

Aviation Program: Students will have an immersive aviation experience as they discover a love of flying. Activities will include flight simulation, an aviation field trip experience, and flying an airplane.



PQFlix - July 6-11, 2025, grades 9-12

Film Program: Students will have a fascinating film experience as they learn the art of visual and narrative storytelling. They will work alongside peers interested in filmmaking to produce a film.
