VOLUNTEERS-REMINDER!!!

The Idaho Conference has voted a NAD policy that all local volunteers be required to have background checks. We are already doing this with volunteers who work with children. This wider inclusion for all volunteers is an added measure for the safety of our children and, although requiring more involvement to maintain, is time and energy well spent. If you are renewing your screening (every three years), you may receive email reminders from ncsrisk directly (if you are over a year late, you may not receive these notices). If you have completed this process for another Adventist group (volunteering at BVAS or GSAA or another SDA Church in the NAD) you do not need to complete the process again. Either add Cloverdale to your organizations, or let the church office know and we can ask the conference office to search for your name (the system does not automatically find you).

The Cloverdale church will cover all costs associated with the screenings.

Dear Friends,

As many of you know, our schools are struggling. Adventist education and tuition assistance have a special place in my heart. This fall, your purchases will benefit the school of your choice.

For every Vege-Food case purchased, \$5 will go to the school of your choice. Use discount code TUITION26 and make note of the school name and location on your order. At the end of Oct., I will tally up each school's donation and send each school a check. I'm excited to see what we can do together!

As I was punching up orders last summer, I realized maybe some online ordering tips would be a good discussion to have.

Tip 1: If you are using the search bar on the website to enter a description that isn't spelled exactly the way it is in the system. For example, if you type in "chicken nuggets" it will show "Sorry, we couldn't find any results," but if you hit the search button, options will populate the screen, and what you are looking for is often there with its unique spelling ("Chik'n Nuggets").

Tip 2: Upon checking out, I've noticed that while looking for the drop-off city as you scroll down, you often have to go to the next page. The next page often starts at the bottom, where you left off scrolling on the previous page, so you have to scroll up to see the list on that page. When you advance pages again, it will start the next page wherever you left off scrolling on the last page. If you know that, it isn't a big deal, but if you don't realize what it is doing, it can make finding your drop-off location difficult. I hope you find this helpful.
